Alice in Wonderland -
and Alice Liddell (the real Alice) in Llandudno

Where it all Started

'Alice's Adventures in Wonderland' is a fictional novel published in 1865 by Charles Lutwidge Dodgson, using the pseudonym Lewis Carroll. The author wrote a sequel, six years later (1871), titled 'Through the Looking-Glass, and What Alice Found There'.

The Hotel Connection

St Tudno Hotel's connection with the books began when Alice Liddell, the inspiration for the 'Alice' character in the books, stayed in Llandudno in 1861. She was eight years old, and on holiday with her family when Charles Lutwidge Dodson (Lewis Carroll) visited the family. The census for that year (population 318) shows the Liddell family residing at what is now the St Tudno Hotel - and it is the only remaining Llandudno property with such an illustrious connection.
